### SUMMER DAY CAMP FEES

FRCC members: \$100 per week per camper  
Non-members: \$125 per week per camper  
Week of July 4\*: \$60 per member  
\$75 per non-member

Price covers all camp activities (except early drop off and late pick up).

Campers qualify for the member rate if they or their parents/legal guardians are FRCC members.

### PAYMENT TERMS

Payment for your child's first week of camp must be made in full at the time of registration. Payment in full for subsequent weeks is due no later than two weeks prior to start of the week attending. There will be no exceptions to payment terms and no refunds are offered.

### FINANCIAL AID

Thanks to the support of the community, financial assistance may be available based on family need. The amount of funding is limited. Please inquire at the Courtesy Desk for more information and an application.

### AGE GROUPS

Camp is open to boys and girls ages 6-13. FRCC camp programs are age appropriate and campers will be divided into groups for most activities. (Minimum age: 6 years of age before September 1, 2019 and must have completed kindergarten. Maximum age is 13. Camper may not turn 14 before September 1, 2019.)

### GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

The FRCC Summer Day Camp program operates Monday through Friday, June 10 through August 9, 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. each day. Standard drop-off begins at 8 a.m.; camper pick-up is at 5 p.m. Parents may register their child for any or all of the weekly sessions (as space is available). Contact us at 301-241-5085 or stop by the FRCC Courtesy Desk if you have any questions about camp. An orientation for parents/guardians will be held in June prior to the first day of camp (date and time to be announced). Additional materials and information, such as Camp Rules and a "What to bring to camp" list will be provided to parents prior to the start of camp. ## FRCC Summer Camp 2019 Weekly Themes

*A traditional Summer Camp experience that features specialized activities based on weekly themes. Specialists, educators, historians, artisans, crafters, fitness instructors, athletes, and camp counselors lead the specialized activities each week.*

June 10 - 14 **Outdoor Adventure I**  
Canoeing & kayak instruction on Lake Royer, scavenger hunt, raptor and reptile encounters, fishing and lots of outdoor fun!

June 17 - 21 **Ultimate Sports**  
Soccer, basketball, and other sports. Learn rules, fundamentals, and sportsmanship. Enjoy indoor and outdoor games.

June 24 - 28 **Kids Boot Camp**  
Enjoy Laser Tag and other active games, meet veterans, learn flag respect, and get an intro to military-style physical fitness training.

July 1 - 3 **Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math (STEAM I)** Participate in fun science experiments, engineering activities, LEGO robotics, and arts.

July 8 - 12 **Crime Scene Investigators (CSI)**  
It's time to crack the case through live clues, games, fingerprinting, DNA studies, and scavenger hunts. Campers will even get to meet with local law enforcement to discuss their evidence!

July 15 - 19 **NEW Space & Aviation**  
Fly high during an 'out-of-this-world' week! Campers will get to build and launch model rockets, see a drone demonstration, create space-themed crafts, and more!

July 22 - 26 **Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math (STEAM II)**  
Science experiments, engineering activities, LEGO robotics, and arts will be the focus of this week!

July 29 - Aug. 2 **Creativity-Arts**  
Show your creativity as crafters and artists lead interactive experiences with pottery, painting, sketching, carving and more.

Aug. 5 - 9 **Outdoor Adventure 11**  
Wrap up the summer 2019 with outdoor fun! Fishing, kayaking, and a special visit from some feathery friends.
